- 5. Be a Greeter to welcome people to Knox
- 6. Set up refreshments for fellowship after Sunday services
- 7. Participate in the Knox Women's Auxiliary who sponsor several events throughout each year that bring people together to enjoy good food and fellowship
- Attend a Bible study group giving the opportunity for discussion and reflection on God's Word
- 9. Join a Prayer Group to pray for God's leading and blessing for the church, the community and individuals in need
- 10. Volunteer to be part of the Community breakfast by the Men team just one Saturday morning every four weeks is a big contribution to Knox and a way to meet other members of the congregation. Over 100,000 home cooked breakfasts have been served!
